



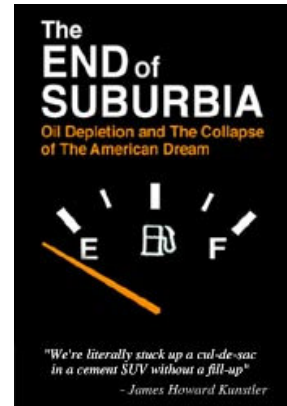
The Post Carbon Institute and Los Angeles Post Carbon Present
